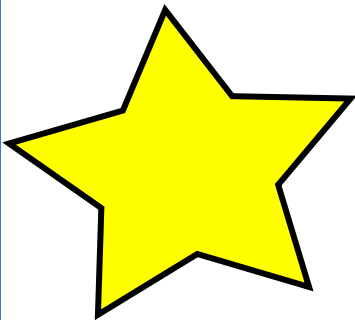


## Pokémon and Football Cards
