Star Reader Competition - Afternoon Tea

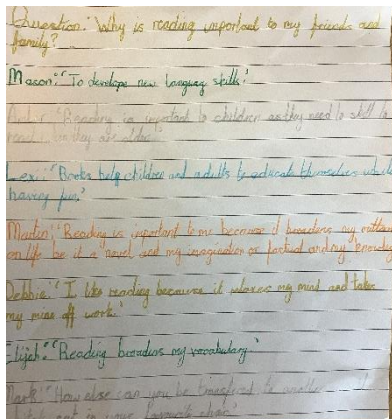
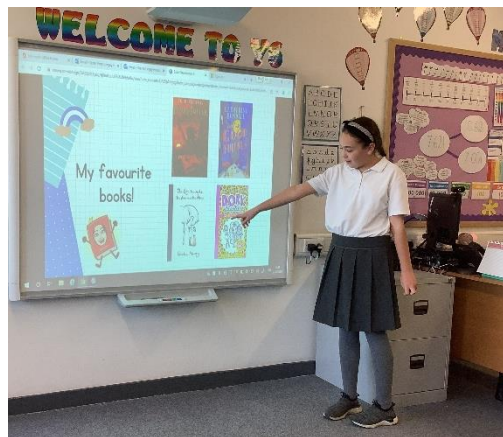
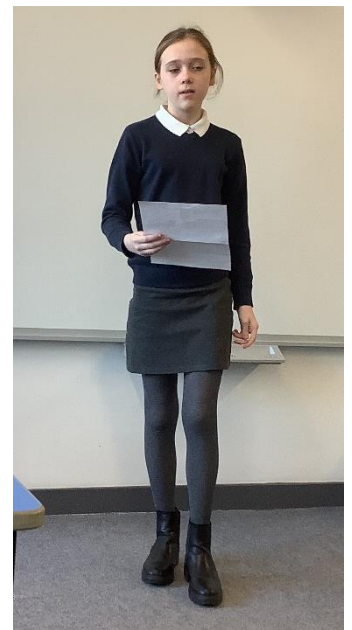
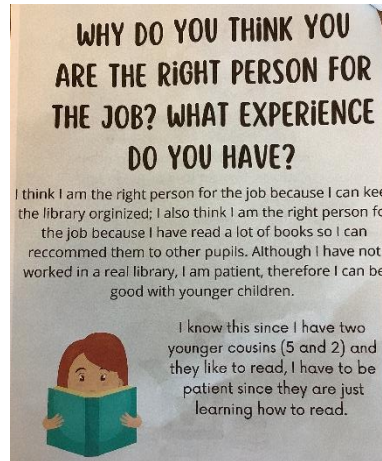
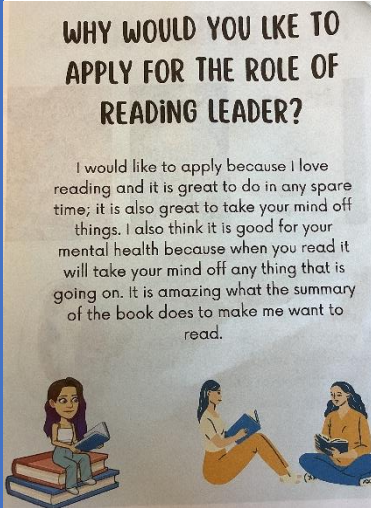
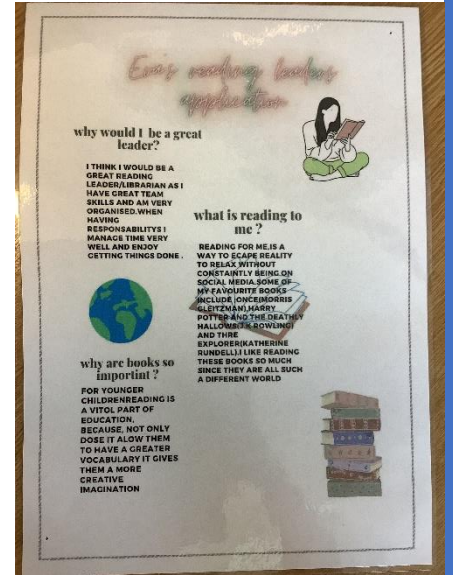
This afternoon, the winners of our World Book Day Star Reading competition enjoyed afternoon tea with Mrs. Wilkinson.

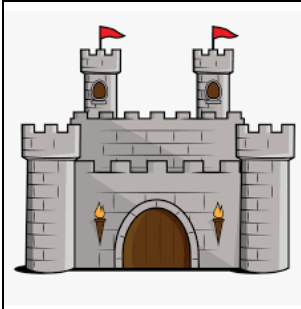
