Gateshead Autism Information Hub

The Autism Information Hub is available to anyone with an Interest in autism - parents/carers/family members, professionals, practitioners, or autistic individuals.

The Autism Information Hub monthly drop-ins offer:

- access to a wide range of books, information and resources on a variety of autism topics, including training, social events, group activities etc
- a relaxed refreshment area where visitors can meet people and share experiences
- guidance and signposting to appropriate support services and voluntary and charity organisations operating
- free exclusive access to the sensory room for parents and carers attending the drop-in (children must be supervised by an adult at all times in the sensory room)

Drop in sessions held on the second Monday of each month 9:30 to 11:30am.


