Year 3 and 4 Quad Kids

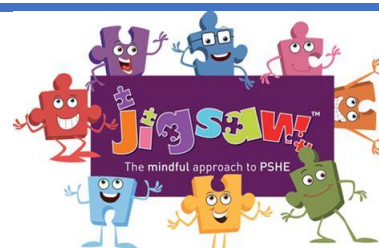
On Thursday 9th June, 16 children from years 3 and 4 took part in Quad Kids at Lord Lawson.

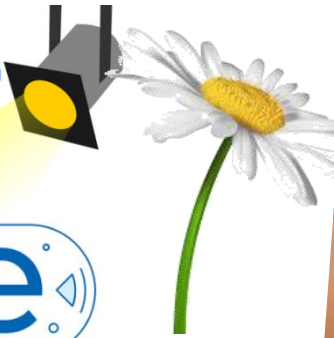

Science

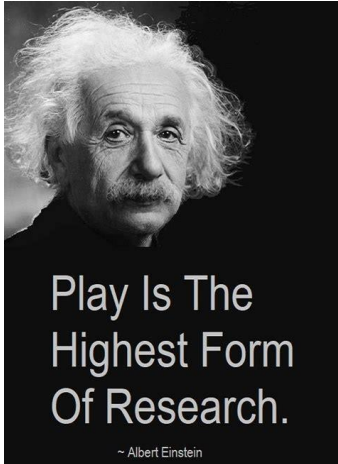


Our brilliant botanists in Year 1 have had lots of fun in science this week. Using our school environment, the children searched for different plants - from dinky daisies to tremendous trees.

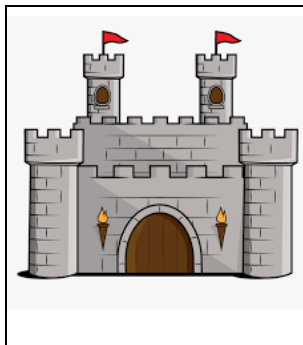
