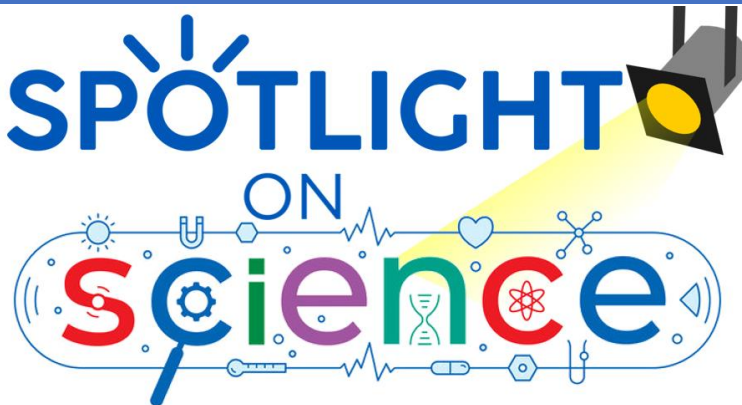
### OPAL- We need your help!

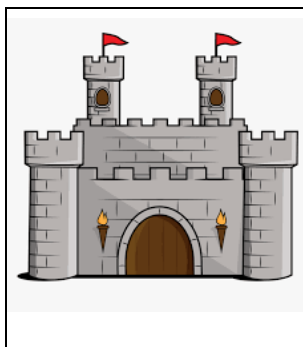
