# Changes to Spelling

This year we have reviewed our approach to homework in school, part of this means that children are no longer bringing home spellings to learn. Please find some information below from Miss Ibinson (our spelling lead) about our new approach to spellings.

We are very excited to let you know about our new spelling scheme in school. Based on Jane Considine's new programme "The Spelling Book," our new approach has moved away from sending spellings home to practise and are now focusing on dedicating more time during the school day to it. Often, children can spell words immediately after they have been learning them, but then can't apply this to their independent writing. Our new approach to spelling looks closely at the sounds within words and how they link to other words. For example, if a child can spell bomb, they know that <mbis a way of spelling the 'm' sound which is also in tomb and comb. This transferability is essential to becoming a good speller and will help children to broaden their vocabulary and make "best guesses" at new words they come across.

We hope that this new programme will encourage children to look closely at words and see new links between them as well as meeting the targets set out by the national curriculum. We ask that in place of practising your child's spellings, you focus on hearing them read aloud and encouraging them to enjoy spending time getting lost in a good book!


We would like you to support your child at home in the following ways:
