

World Book Day



Thursday 3rd March 2022 marks the 25th anniversary of World Book Day! Since its creation, the wonderful people at World Book Day have worked tirelessly to promote reading for pleasure and offer every child the opportunity to own a book of their own. This year, our theme is going to be 'Little and Large'! From larger than life characters such as the BFG and the Smartest Giant in Town to the tiniest such as Stuart Little or Peter Rabbit - we are going to be celebrating author's use of size and shape to create fantastic, magical stories. Here are some of the exciting things we have planned to mark this special occasion:

Dressing up

As always, we are inviting all children and staff to come into school on the 3rdMarch dressed as their favourite book character and armed with their favourite book. You do not have to base your costume around the theme – just go with whatever your children want. There are some fantastic ideas online if you're stuck, so please don't feel like you need to buy something new. We can't wait to see all of your costumes!

Treasure Hunt

All children will have the chance to take part in a treasure hunt around school, looking for items which our little and large characters have lost. They will then have to explain who they think has lost which object and say why.

Reading Star Competition

Reading for pleasure is something which should be celebrated all of the time, not just on World Book Day. From today, there will be a Reading Star competition posted on SeeSaw for the children to complete between now and World Book Day.
